

# **POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN INFORMATION COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (1618)**

## **D.167 ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Unless the Senate determines otherwise for admission to the **Postgraduate Diploma in Information Communication Technology – PGDip (Information Communication Technology)** applicants should have obtained an undergraduate degree with an average of 60% in the final assessment of the exit-modules in any field.

## **D.168 SELECTION**

As only a limited number of students can be admitted to the programme, applicants will be subject to a selection procedure.

## **D.169 DURATION**

The duration of the Postgraduate Diploma is one year full-time or two year part-time subject to Rule A.4.1.

## **D.170 CURRICULUM**

Students will be required to complete the seven taught modules. Teaching and learning will take place in the form of teaching blocks spread across the year. All modules and attendance are compulsory.

Students who successfully complete the coursework and the practical internship will graduate with a PG Diploma. The PG Diploma could provide entrance into the Master's Degree upon consultation with Head of Department of Information Systems.
