### **C.158 ADMISSION**

- C.165.3** Candidates will be required to present their proposals on a prescribed date determined by the department before handing in the final proposals to the Higher Degrees and Senate Higher Degrees Committees.

- C.165.5** Additional or related modules in the subject area may be required.
