E.112 ADMISSION

Unless Senate decides otherwise, candidates will be required to meet the following criteria to be enrolled for the programme: **Postgraduate Diploma in Technical and Vocational Education and Training - PGDip (Technical and Vocational Education and Training)**

A University degree and an appropriate teacher's qualification, or qualifications agree to be equivalent to both a cognate qualification and in teaching. Teaching qualifications recognized by the University as equivalent to M+4; or an Advance Certificate in Education at NQF Level 6 or its equivalent. B Degree or equivalent in cognate discipline area plus initial teaching qualification or equivalent as may be determined through RPL processes.

E.113 SELECTION

As only a limited number of students can be admitted to the programme, applicants will be subject to a selection procedure.

E.116.1 Part-time
