C.150 ADMISSION

Unless Senate decides otherwise, candidates will be required to meet the following criteria to be enrolled for the programme: **Doctor of Theology – DTh**

- (a) A student shall have obtained a Master's degree or equivalent qualification in the subject (s)he wishes to study and submit proof thereof, and
- (b) satisfied Senate as to his/her proficiency in the subject.

C.151 SELECTION

As only a limited number of students can be admitted to the programme, applicants will be subject to a selection procedure.
