### **J.210 ADMISSION**

Unless Senate decides otherwise, candidates will be required to meet the following criteria to be enrolled for the degree: **Master of Arts in Biokinetics - MA (Biokinetics)**

- J.210.1** Candidates must be in possession of a BA Hons Biokinetics degree, and subject to Rule A.2.4.2.
- J.210.2** Candidates may apply directly to the SRES Department if they are not in possession of an appropriate degree subject to Rule A.2.1.4.
- J.210.3** If, in the opinion of the HOD, the relevant Honours degree is deficient, additional work may be required.

### **J.211 SELECTION**

As only a limited number of students can be admitted to the programme, applicants will be subject to a selection procedure.

### **J.212 DURATION**

Unless Senate decides otherwise the maximum period of study shall extend over three years. Subject to Rule A.4.
