

MASTER OF ADMINISTRATION (Thesis – 1811)

D.283 ADMISSION

Unless Senate decides otherwise, a student shall be required to meet the following criteria to be enrolled for the **Master of Administration Degree – MAdmin (as indicated in D.286 below)**:

D.283.1 Admission to a Master's Degree is at the discretion of the department, subject to the general rules of the University. An applicant who has not taken a research methodology module would be required to complete that module.

D.284 SELECTION

Final selection shall be based on an applicant meeting the criteria as determined by the Faculty.

D.285 DURATION

Unless Senate decides otherwise, the duration of the programme shall extend over three years full-time or part-time.

D.286 CURRICULUM

The programme comprises of the following specialisation areas, namely Public Administration, Political Studies and Industrial Psychology.
